## Teresa Scanlan

When Teresa Scanlan was crowned Miss America 2011, she became the youngest woman to wear the crown in over 70 years and the very first Miss Nebraska to become Miss America. Teresa is the daughter of Mark and Janie Scanlan and is from Gering, Nebraska.

As the middle child of seven,

Teresa was homeschooled through her junior year of high school and then graduated a year early in 2010.

She will be attending Patrick Henry College in the fall of 2012, and plans on majoring in government. She then plans to attend Harvard Law to become a criminal prosecutor, hoping to become a judge and eventually be involved in the political arena. As a Christian, she hopes to break down the stereotype of crooked and dishonest politicians, operating instead with character and integrity.
